

MINUTES OF THE JOINT STUDY SESSION OF THE SHOW LOW CITY COUNCIL AND PINETOP-LAKESIDE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2022, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 325 WEST WHITE MOUNTAIN BOULEVARD, PINETOP, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA.

1. Call to Order.

Mayor Stephanie Irwin of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

2. Roll Call.

3. Invocation.

4. Welcome and Introduction of Delegates. (Mayor Irwin)

Mayor Irwin welcomed all and introductions were made.

5. Community Emergency Communication Update. (Chief Dan Barnes/Chief Brad Provost/Chief Deputy Swanty)

Chief Dan Barnes of Pinetop-Lakeside shared progress made on the Emergency Communication system for Navajo County.

Chief Brad Provost of Show Low shared statistics of calls handled by the Communication system. Chief Provost stated that as of June of 2022 the system has mobile capability, adding if there was an evacuation the mobile unit would allow operation of the Emergency Communication System from off-site. Chief Provost stated that Show Low was in the preliminary stages of plan review for moving the Dispatch Center to the old Show Low Police Department.

Sheriff Clouse of Navajo County shared his appreciation and the importance of the agencies in Navajo County working together.

Lieutenant Whipple of Navajo County shared information on the new 911 dispatch capabilities.
